TO THE CHOIRMASTER: WITH STRINGED INSTRUMENTS; ACCORDING TO THE SHEMINITH. A PSALM OF DAVID.

1 O LORD, rebuke me not in your anger,

nor discipline me in your wrath.

2 Be gracious to me, O LORD, for I am languishing;

heal me, O LORD, for my bones are troubled.

3 My soul also is greatly troubled.

But you, O LORD—how long?

4 Turn, O LORD, deliver my life;

save me for the sake of your steadfast love.

Rebukes and Disciplines -v. 1

Gracious -v. 2; Healer -v. 2

Deliverer -v. 4; Steadfast love -v. 4

Hears our weeping -v. 8

Hears my plea, accepts my prayer -v. 9

God's discipline never brings despair, but always has a word of hope, healing, and restoration

## **Prayer Prompts**

Lord, I praise You that You have been gracious to me when...

Lord, I give You thanks for hearing and answering me when I cried out to You about...

RESPONSE
"I surrender my trouble of and will patiently wait for You Lord to respond." (v. 2-4) "Lord, I confess my weariness about and trust that You will bring deliverance." (v.6-7)
"I repent of my impatience and doubt as I wait for You to answer my cry for" (v. 6-7)
REQUEST
Lord, please bring your deliverance/healing to (name) and help him/her look to You alone in their trouble.  For the sake of Your steadfast love, bring salvation to my (mention specific loved
ones; friends; neighbors; co-workers)
Because You know my weeping about please strengthen and sustain me so I can give you praise!
READINESS
<ul> <li>O Lord, cause workers of evil to depart from my(name specific areas of your life where you are facing battles and/or temptation)</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Turn back and put to shame the enemies presence in(person, circumstance, etc).</li> <li>(Antiphonal Response) ALL: "The Lord has heard my cry!"</li> </ul>
